Key Stage 3

The aim of this curriculum is to develop the listening, reading, writing and speaking skills of all students to prepare them for the demands of the GCSE curriculum. The department has created new and exciting Schemes of Learning which further engage and motivate students such as learning about Spies and Villains, art and music and Francophone countries to name a few topics.

Key Stage 4

At the start of Year 9, students continue to develop the skills which they will need in order to be successful at GCSE level. Students follow the new Edexcel specification and complete four external examinations in reading, writing, listening and speaking. Students study a range of topics including holidays, hobbies, the environment, school and healthy living.

Key Stage 5
