Dear Parents/Carers

The GCSE examination are well under way and I am pleased to report that our Yr11 students have made a positive start to this important period.

I would like to take this opportunity to share with you the teaching arrangements for the next few weeks. **Yr11 students are expected to attend school for all lessons up until the chemistry exam on Wednesday 14 June.** This will ensure that all our Yr11s will have access to the subject teachers and revision resources. A thorough revision timetable means that before examinations, students have specific revision slots with their regular class teacher. This is coupled with normal timetabled lessons.
