### **Celebrate Success Assemblies**

Many of you will be receiving certificates in the post in the next few days celebrating the progress and attainment of our students in their lessons. Every teaching group in every subject nominates a class winner. These students will all receive a certificate for either progress or attainment acknowledging their achievement. Staff then select an overall winner for each subject for both progress and attainment and all these prize winners also gain house points that go towards their personal total and the overall house scores. Well done to all of our nominees and winners. They can be very proud of their achievements.

As well as recognizing student achievements in lessons we also recognise students for demonstrating the LORIC principles of **L**eadership, **O**rganisation, **R**esilience, **I**nitiative and **C**ommunication. The form tutors select one student from their form to receive the much sought after Form Tutor Award. Well done to all this terms winners.
