### **Mr Hunter**

It is with great sadness that we will be saying goodbye to Mr Hunter on Friday 26 June. Mr Hunter will pass by the school for the last time at approximately 1:15pm heading towards The Anvil pub. I am aware that many people are rightly intending to come and pay their respects as the funeral procession passes by the school. Because we have staff and students in school who are operating in separate bubbles we will need to ensure their safety. This means the school gates including all car parks will be closed. Can I ask that if you intend to attend, that you maintain a 2m social distance and that you use the entire length of the road for everyone's safety. If you are driving can you please park safely on the surrounding roads, allowing plenty of space for the procession to pass and plenty of time for you to find a space to stand safely along the full length of Reddicap Heath Road. We do expect a high attendance so please bear this in mind and allow plenty of time when planning your journey.
