Dear Parents and Carers

I hope that you and your families are keeping safe and well in these unusual times.

I am writing to with regards to the Year 10 GCSE statistics class and explain the school's process of administering the results. Results day this year will be taking place on Thursday 20 August 2020.

I am sure that you can appreciate that this is not a usual results day and we are doing all we can to ensure that we are adhering to effective social distancing and protective measures. With this in mind, the school is asking that the Year 10 class of statistics students receive the results by either school email or post and are not collected in person on the day.

In the first instance, the GCSE Statistics results will be **emailed to your child's John Willmott School email account** by noon on Thursday 20 August. This will mean that your child only has access to the results without the need to travel to our site. If you child has forgotten a password to access this email address, please contact results2020@jws.bham.sch.uk by 4pm on Tuesday 18 August for a reset to be sent. The results will also be posted home on the afternoon of Thursday 20 August.

Please also note that given the circumstances, this day will not be an opportunity for parents and students to appeal the GCSE result. We will provide Ofqual guidance in results envelopes that you can refer to. If you have specific queries regarding the grade, this should be sent to results2020@jws.bham.sch.uk. **Please do not contact any member of the maths staff**, who due to the process this year are unable to respond to queries relating to individual results.

When your child returns to school in September, we will have an opportunity to talk to you about the course that will be followed in Year 11 for this class, but please be rest assured that the maths team have been preparing the course and qualification to be accessed.
